Sub:- Establishment – Factories Department – Make in India – Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion - Ease of doing business – payment of the licence fee by the Managements - Certain instructions – issued – Reg.

All the Subordinate officers are informed that the every licence granted shall be valid till it has been duly cancelled. Every license shall, before the commencement of any calendar year, pay the annual licence fee of such amount as is prescribed in the Licence Fee Schedule of the Andhra Pradesh Factories Rules, 1950 (given in Annexure) for each calendar year or up to ten times the Annual Licence Fee Prescribed in the said Schedule in case, provided that the period for which licence applied is for one year or more but does not exceed 10 years. Fees Payable for renewal shall be equal to number of years applied for renewal times of the Annual Licence Fee.

If the prescribed annual licence fee is not fully paid within the prescribed period, simple interest at two percent per month or part of a month shall be payable on the part of the fee not paid from the first day of the calendar year till the last day of the calendar month in which the fee together with interest is paid.

The licensee needs to register himself in the Factories Department website (www.tsfactories.cgg.gov.in) and select the service – payment of Annual License Fee. In the online application page, he/she needs to select the number of years for which he/she is interested in paying the annual Licence fee. There is no need to upload any document along with the online application. After making the payment, the Entrepreneur should take the print – out of the acknowledgement and keep it in records.

The instructions shall be followed scrupulously.
